In January 2013, Professor Connors became the author for Siegel, New York Practice. The publication's sixth edition, *David D. Siegel and Patrick M. Connors, New York Practice (6th ed. 2018 Thomson)* is available in hard copy, ebook, and on Westlaw. The treatise has been cited in thousands of reported decisions and has been called "The Bible" for litigation in New York State courts.
